



## **Admissions for Pre- Primary School**



### **Aim:**

- Our aim is to provide education to children through creative play. Learning experiences should happen in a fun and relaxed environment.
- As most of our children are from different ethnicities and background we encourage them to learn about different cultures by celebrating global festivals and traditions from around the globe.
- We want our children to be excited about school. Therefore, we aim to provide them with a positive first experience of life at school.



### **Entry Requirements:**

- We do not believe in interviewing a child.
- The school follows a Montessori teaching approach
- All of our teachers are Montessori trained/qualified or undergoing training

## **Toddlers**

We accept toddlers from the age of 18 months to 2 ½ years.



### **Most common questions:**

1. Does our child need to be potty trained?  
Our teachers are fully trained to provide potty training to young children.

2. What are the activities for Toddlers?

- Our curriculum is based on the Montessori Method which focuses on the child's exploration and creativity
- Extra-Curricular activities include ballet, music lessons, football, outings, yoga, clay modeling, puppetry and storytelling.

3. What are the school times for toddlers?

The school time for toddlers is between 9:00am to 12:00pm

### **Pre-Nursery**

We accept children from 2 ½ to 3½ years old



#### **Most common questions:**

1. What are the school timings?

The school time for pre-nursery is between 8:30 am to 1:30pm (winter) and between 8:00am to 1:00pm (summer).

2. Are meals provided in the school?

3. What are the things that my child needs to bring to school?

- Almanac/Diary (Provided by the school)
- Wet Tissues
- Extra clothes
- Water Bottle
- At least 1 diaper (if still using)
- All other stationeries are provided in the school

### **Nursery**

We accept children from 3 ½ to 4 ½ years old.



#### **Most common questions:**

1. What happens if my child gets sick while at school?

Tender Love Care (TLC), the schools clinic is fully equipped which is looked after by a specialist. We have tied up with PARAS hospital, Gurgaon in case of emergency in school.

2. How do I communicate with my child's teacher

Every child gets a diary/almanac in which the teacher uses to send messages to the parent. The parent must check the almanac everyday and take action on the teachers

## **Kindergarten**

We accept children from 4 ½ to 5 ½ years old



### **Most common questions:**

1. How can I avail of the school transport?

2. Does my child need to wear a uniform?
  - All students from Pre-nursery to upper classes are to wear uniforms.
  - Children are advised to keep jewellery to a minimum. The school will not be held responsible for lost or misplaced items.
  - Our uniforms are outsourced. The company visits the school every Wednesday and Saturday from 10:00am to 1:00pm.



### **What is Montessori Method?**

The Montessori Method believes that children learn directly from their environment and other children. The teacher is there to facilitate the child's exploration and creativity.

All subjects are interwoven and the child learns at their own pace. This helps each child gain independence and confidence, and be proud of their own achievement. Montessori children are usually very adaptable. They have learned to work independently and in groups.



### **Day Care Facility**
